

LHS Saturday School Rules:

- Saturday detention is 8:00 – 11:00 a.m. unless otherwise specified by the principal.
- Students must report to the library doors.
- If tardiness occurs, the student will serve two extra minutes for every minute they are tardy, at the end of the Saturday detention.
- If the student is more than 15 minutes tardy they will not be allowed in the school, and they will be considered absent.
- When a student is absent from Saturday detention, the parent is required to contact the principal within two days and inform the principal of the reason for the absence. The principal will decide the consequence for any absences which could include suspension.
- All Saturday time must be completed by the end of each semester or the student will not earn credit for their classes until the time is served. (Education State Statute 21-4-308 (c))
- If a student is attending Saturday school, for reasons other than a detention (typically on a volunteer basis to do school work) they will be allowed in after 15 minutes.
- No drugs, alcohol or tobacco: Consequence - Student will be sent home and other consequences applied.
- School dress code will be followed or student will be sent home.

One warning will be given on all of the following (If a student does not follow these rules and they are sent home, the student will repeat the entire Saturday school no matter how long they were in attendance. Other school discipline may be applied pending the infraction):

- No Talking
- Students will sit in their desks.
- Come prepared with school work – may go to locker if needed.
- No eating or drinking
- No music/No headphones
- No cell phone or other electronic devices: All cell phones will be collected.
- No moving unless permission is given
- No leaving the room unless permission is given
- No disrespect for the teacher in charge.
- All other school rules apply
