



## Economic Hardship Waiver for Student Fees

A student or his/her parent or legal guardian may request and receive a waiver of payment of a fee due to economic hardship. Waivers of fees shall be granted based on objective criteria relative to the student or his/her family, as listed below:

- Foster Care
- Homeless
- Emancipated
- Unemployment

This written request for a waiver of fees shall be submitted to the principal of the school or his/her designee for consideration. Proof of eligibility shall be included with the fee waiver request. A written decision on the waiver request shall be rendered within five (5) school days of the date of receipt of the request. Should the initial request to the principal of the school for a waiver be denied, a written appeal may be made to Superintendent or his/her designee, who shall respond to the appeal in writing within five (5) school days of the receipt of the appeal.

## Hackberry Fees/Dues List

### Freshman class dues \$40

### Student Council dues \$25

Used to pay District, State, and Southern dues and club t-shirt. (This is reduced depending on hours worked at various events in the community.)

### Cheerleading \$150

Used to pay for uniforms, camp, accessories, and camp clothing. (This is reduced depending on profit from Marshland.)

### PreK Supplies \$45

Covers most of the school supplies needed for the year.
