Child Find

The Cranbury School District is conducting a search for Cranbury residents between the ages of 3 to 21 who are experiencing difficulties in the areas of listening, speaking, reading, writing, math skills or motor development and who may be eligible for special education and related services or services under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act. The child study team has programs available for evaluating children with these difficulties to determine their needs.

In addition, the child study team is specifically trying to locate and assist preschool children residing in the district experiencing a developmental delay or a disability and who may be eligible for special education and related services. The child study team will meet with parents and guardians to determine if evaluations are warranted and eligible children will be provided with a special education program at no cost to the parents.

The State Department of Health Services also has programs for children from birth to three years of age. The Cranbury School Child Study Team has information concerning these programs.
