MEAL DISTRIBUTION UPDATE

We know that school closures are impacting families differently across our community. Jubilee Academies is committed to helping our families during this closure. The Child Nutrition Department will prepare and distribute meals for children 18 years and younger at several sites while school is closed due to COVID-19 precautions. Children do not have to attend Jubilee Academies to qualify, but we do ask that children be present at pick-up. TECH & INSTRUCTION PACKET PICK-UP
