

SCHOOL DAY

The Governing Board shall fix the length of the school day subject to the provisions of law. (Education Code 46100)

The school day shall be arranged and scheduled by the administration so as to offer the greatest return educationally for the time spent, within the limitations of school facilities and requirements of state law and regulations.

School hours shall be arranged to provide for safety and supervision of students and to accommodate the working day of the professional staff.

Students may arrive on campus no sooner than thirty minutes before the first regularly scheduled class and must depart campus upon dismissal from class.

Exceptions to this rule may be made if a professional staff member has made arrangements for a supervised activity and if the principal has been notified.

Each principal shall be responsible for posting school hours at the entrance to the school. (Education Code 32211(e))

At the beginning of each school year, the administration shall notify parents/guardians in writing of the arrival and departure time for students.
