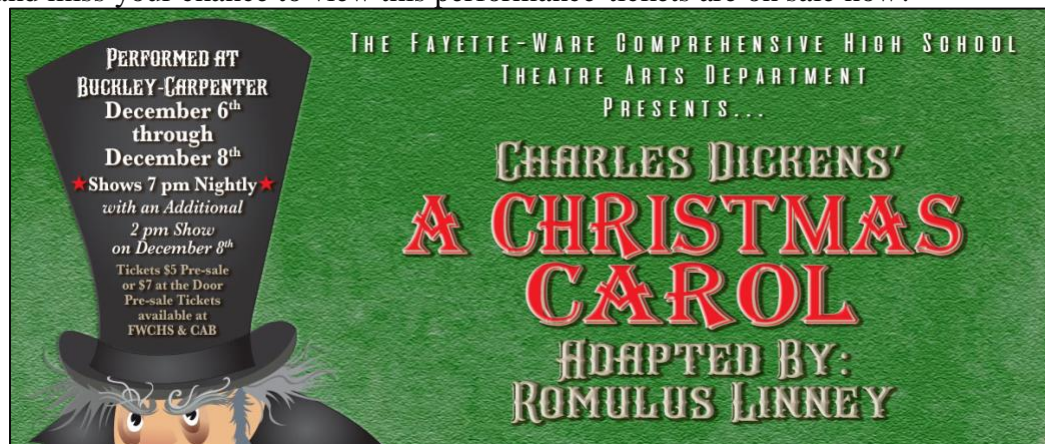
Andrew works diligently on academics, currently maintaining a 3.7 GPA while attending honors classes and consistently appearing on the Honor Roll and Principal's List.

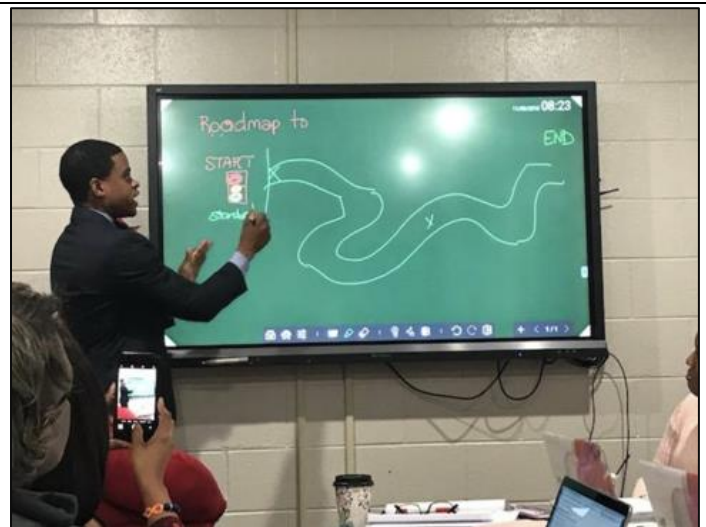
Healthy Students Are Better Learners
