Senior Prom Information 2019

This year's Senior Prom will be held on Friday, May 3, 2019 from 6:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. at Manufacturers Golf & Country Club, 511 Dreshertown Road, Fort Washington PA 19034. **Students are expected to be there no later than 7:00 p.m.** All students will have dinner at the Prom. Photographs are included as part of the ticket price.

Senior Mtg: All parents and their seniors must have participated in the [Mandatory On-line Senior Meeting](#) by **April 9th** . You can access the On-line meeting by clicking on "Senior Meeting 2019" under the Student Life tab on lansdalecatholic.com.

Form Info: The Senior Prom Permission **form must be filled out and returned Tuesday April 9**. Students received this form in homeroom on Tuesday April 2. ONE FORM SHOULD BE COMPLETED PER COUPLE (If a senior is attending without a date, only the top half of the form needs to be filled out). There are two sections on the first page of the form; one section for each LC student and his and her guardian to sign. The back of the form only needs to be completed if an LC student is bringing a guest from outside of the school.

Time: Friday, May 3, 2019 from 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.
Students may not leave the prom until 10:30 p.m. unless the Asst. Principal for Student Affairs receives letters from the parents of both students stating their knowledge of and consent to the early departure. The time must be clearly stated. These letters must be submitted to the Student Affairs Office no later than the day before the Prom. If a student/couple has not arrived by 7:00 p.m., parents will be notified.

Dress Code: Formal (gowns and tuxedos) Young ladies must wear long gowns that are clearly below the knee and do not show a bare or translucent midriff or have any revealing cut-outs. Dresses should be appropriate for a Catholic school and inline with Catholic moral teachings. Young men are expected to dress in tuxedos. All are expected to maintain the dress code throughout the evening.

Tuition: Tuition and fees must be up-to-date in order to purchase a ticket to any class dance. Please see the Tuition Officer if you have any questions regarding this.

Tickets: Tickets will be sold in the Activities Office on **Monday to Wednesday, April 15 to 17** during the lunch periods. Tickets will **not** be sold at the door. All permission forms **must** be completed, signed and returned by **Tuesday, April 9** in order to purchase a ticket.

Ticket Cost: \$100 per person. **This price includes dinner & picture package.** Please put 8-digit student ID# on checks.

Pre-prom: Pre-prom parties, whether parent-sponsored or not, are not endorsed by the school. Students under the influence of Alcohol or Drugs will not be permitted into the prom and will be detained until their parents can come for them. The Asstant Principal for Student Services will be notified to handle the situation.

Post-prom: The school does not approve of after-prom parties. We officially discourage parents from sponsoring such events.

Any LC student on disciplinary probation may not attend the Senior Prom. Anyone who does not conduct himself or herself as a gentlemen or lady will be asked to leave the prom. The parents of these students will be notified immediately, and the Assistant Principal for Student Services will handle the situation accordingly. Anyone who, in the opinion of the chaperones or faculty, is in possession of or under the influence of Alcohol or drugs will be detained until parents come for them or until police escort them home. Such violations will result in suspension and possible expulsion. For more information regarding the school's Drug and Alcohol Policy see the Family Handbook. Any student removed from the Prom for any reason will not be entitled to a refund.

ALL OF THESE RULES APPLY EVEN IF THE STUDENT'S DATE IS OVER 21 OR ATTENDS ANOTHER SCHOOL. ALL OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE ESTABLISHED SCHOOL POLICIES FOR THE SAFETY AND PROTECTION OF OUR STUDENTS.
