Homeless girls are in particular need of housing, making wise financial decisions and of finding beauty within themselves and in our world.

PROTECT YOURSELF FROM GERMS AND VIRUSES

Hand Washing = the best defense

When to wash your hands:

- Before and after you eat
- After you cough, sneeze or blow your nose
- After you use the bathroom
- After any contact with germs or dirt

How to wash your hands:

- Wet hands with warm water
- Apply a generous amount of soap
- For 3- seconds, scrub all parts of your hands and wrists
- Rinse and dry completely

*Or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer and rub until hands are dry
