Dear Sir/Madam:

My name is Craig Wallace and I am an Architect with Stiles, Wallace & Associates located in Lubbock, Texas. I am currently working with Wink-Loving Independent School District on their 2018 Bond Package that was approved by the voters this past May.

The District is in need of a new Elementary School which will require 60,000 additional square feet of space on campus. The District and I have determined that the construction of the new elementary cannot be in the current location due to traffic safety and flooding concerns that exist with the current location. As a result, several facilities must be removed and/or relocated to accommodate this new facility on the existing campus.

One of the facilities scheduled for removal is the original Junior High and High School which has been abandoned for the past 3 years. This location will allow for the construction of new facilities and allow the District to maintain one single campus with newer facilities and much needed parking.

The District plans to pay tribute to this historical facility by constructing a Monument built from various salvaged building components from the building. The Monument will also include additional historic facts, photos and documentation of the buildings history. The District would also like to incorporate the existing marker into the Monument as well.

Please consider this letter as the 60 day notice of demolition as required by Sec. 442.006. State Historical Marker Program paragraph (f).
