1. **Fiscal Stability** - *The Superintendent will work closely with the Business Manager and the Board of Education to find creative approaches to balance the budget in a way that will affect student achievement positively.*

4. **Career Exploration**-*The Superintendent will work with the administration and the guidance counselors to provide students a variety of opportunities towards career exploration, goals, and pathways.*
5. **Student Growth**- *Through the use of defined intervention periods throughout the district, student growth will increase across all levels of the assessment spectrum. This will be noted in the districts SPP profile score and PVASS scores, among other local measures.*
