## General Information:

- Students **will not** be provided a snack in the program. Please send an additional snack for your child to enjoy during Kids' Club activities.
- There will be no club programming on half days.
- Please make sure your child is aware of the clubs he/she will be attending each day. **Please make note of the dates on the calendar that are marked 'No Clubs'.**
- All materials required for participation are included in the cost of the program.
- Programs may have differing prices due to varying costs of running each program and the number of days each program is in session.
- Each club has a maximum number of students that can be accommodated and a minimum number of students required to be registered in order for the club to be offered. The maximum participation and minimum required participation are not adjustable.
- **All fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.**
- Children who are in the regular after school program will be escorted to and from their Kids' Club by a designated teacher. Students are not allowed to leave the school building unescorted by a parent between school dismissal and the start of the Kids' Club or athletic activity.
- Students must be picked up within 10 minutes of their Kids' Club dismissal. Students who are not retrieved in a timely manner will automatically be sent to After School care, and charges for services will be incurred.
- There will be no make-up classes due to weather related issues or unforeseeable circumstances.
- Payment will be made through Smart Tuition. Families will be billed directly on the October statement. Failure to pay Kids' Club program fees will result in denied services and forfeiture of the opportunity to register for future club activities.
- Dismissal from Kids' Club activities will take place out of all three doors (recess yard, east side door, & west side door). The instructor will reach out prior to the first day of programming with dismissal information.

- You will receive a welcome email from each Kids Club teacher at the start of the semester and a second email half way through the semester to provide an update on your child's participation in the program.
- Please note that the satisfactory completion of school assignments and homework are our priorities for all of our students. Kids' Club and athletic activities are always secondary to completing homework and school assignments.
- Kids' Club activities are educational and enjoyable, but participation is a privilege that is earned through positive interactions, cooperation, mutual respect and adherence to the school's policies and procedures. Students who fail to observe the school's code of conduct, or follow the Club teacher's behavioral requirements, will be subject to usual school disciplinary consequences, which may include dismissal from the program.

## Registration Procedures:

- Registration is done online. A form will be emailed to you at 12pm on Thursday, January 9<sup>th</sup>
- Registration is first come, first served.
- The registration form should be filled out once for EACH child. Please do not fill out multiple registration forms for one child. If you believe you made a mistake please send an email to [kidsclubs@saintstephenschool.org](mailto:kidsclubs@saintstephenschool.org). All double registrations will result in the removal from all clubs.
- If you are registering for more than one child you must complete a form for EACH child. Siblings will be given preference to a club as long as the time stamp on the registration form is no longer than 10 minutes apart.
- If your child is placed on the waitlist for any club you will be notified via email the morning on Friday, January 10<sup>th</sup>. At this time you will be advised of clubs with available space and will have until the close of Friday, January 10<sup>th</sup> to make a substitute choice.
- Club confirmation emails will be sent out on Wednesday, January 15<sup>th</sup>. If you do not receive a confirmation email **AFTER** 5:00pm on Wednesday, January 15<sup>th</sup> please send an email to the kids' club email listed above.
- Once you have submitted your registration form, you are committing to the club and will not be able to swap that enrollment for another club.
- A late registration fee of \$25 will be charged per club and per child to anyone who would like to sign up for Kids' Clubs **after** registration has closed on Friday, January 11<sup>th</sup>, provided space is available.

# Monday Clubs

## DIY w/ Ms. Shannon

**Spring Semester Fee \$495**

*Grades:* PreK4 - Grade 2

*Time:* 3:15 – 4:15

Students will focus on making and customizing special and fun Do It Yourself projects. We will explore the process of making everyday items such as soap, bathbombs, perfumes, and lip glosses, to name a few. We will also work with tie dye and screenprinting materials to design shirts, socks, totes, water bottles, and much more! Through this club, students will gain knowledge in elements of design and craft as we build and create functional and stylish projects together. Projects change depending on interests of students.

## Irish Dancing w/ Mrs. Aherne Sheehan School of Irish Dance

## Mathletes w/ Ms. Lynch

Mathletes will explore hands-on puzzles and games to enhance students' mathematical skill set while simultaneously teaching them teamwork, problem solving and abstract thinking techniques. ## Chess Club w/ Parker-Anderson Enrichment

Students develop their problem-solving, analytical, and critical thinking skills. Explore weaving, felting, papermaking, and basketry in this after-school club! We will look at different ways to create art with a hands-on approach and some fun using traditional techniques.



# Tuesday Clubs

## Theatre Games w/ Ms. Jamie Schmidt

**Spring Semester Fee \$495**

*Grades:* PreK3- Grade 1

*Time:* 3:15 – 4:15

This club is created for students to learn about theatre! Through games, students will be taught foundational skills of performance such as projection, acting, vocal and physical warm ups, singing, movement, etc. Additionally, students will learn about other key factors of theatre: costumes, props, lights, and set through games and craft-based activities. Depending on student enrollment, there is an opportunity for the club to have a performance at the end of the spring. Theatre skills taught in this class such as projecting one's voice, using emotion and voice to convey meaning, and working with others to reach a common goal are important social skills students can apply both in and out of the classroom.

## American Girl Adventures w/ Ms. Laurel

**Spring Semester Fee \$495**

*Grades:* PreK4 - Grade 3

*Time:* 3:15 – 4:15

Girls and boys are welcome to come learn about classic American Girl stories and events, create costumes, props, and accessories for their own dolls, and share in experiences while we play and problem solve together!

## Golf w/ Kate Tempesta's Urban Golf Academy

**Spring Semester Fee \$430**

*Grades:* PreK4- Grade 1

*Time:* 3:15 – 4:15

Kate Tempesta's Urban Golf Academy curriculum is built on age-appropriate childhood development techniques, golf skills, and athletic development. Students will engage in age-appropriate activities focused on golf while connecting to physical, social, cultural and academic concepts. The classes and activities empower students to work as part of a team, build self-confidence and sportsmanship skills, and develop an aptitude and love for the game of golf. Kate Tempesta is committed to small group instruction with an individual focus on each student as key to maintaining a natural balance between learning and having fun.

## Sewing Stuffed Animals w/ Ms. Katie

**Spring Semester Fee \$495**

*Grades:* Grade 1 - Grade 6

*Time:* 3:15 – 4:15

Do you love stuffed animals? Do you want to learn how to design and sew your own stuffed animal creations? Join the sewing stuffed animals club! In this club students will learn some simple stitches to sew their stuffed animals by hand. After one guided project students dive into creating and sewing their own stuffed animals. Students generally complete between two and four different stuffed animal over the semester - depending on their level and the size of their creations. You do not need to know how to sew to join this club - I will be there to help you learn. Come create with us!

Filmmaking w/ Ms. Shannon

**Spring Semester Fee \$495**

*Grades:* Grade 4 – Grade 8

*Time:* 3:15 – 4:15

Study and experience the art of filmmaking. During this club, we will study the history of silent film and how it has had a lasting impact on today's current film industry. We will screen and discuss popular silver screen silent films while simultaneously creating a silent film of our own. Students will develop a script, storyboard, and shooting schedule for their story. They will also learn how to shoot and edit their footage to create a finished product to be shared at a special screening party. In this club, students will work as leaders and as part of a team, and will strengthen their storytelling abilities through this dynamic and adaptive art form.

Violin Level 4: Chamber Ensemble Prep w/ Ms. Leon

**Spring Semester Fee \$495**

*Grades:* Grade 5 – Grade 8

*Time:* 3:15 – 3:45

Offered to Chamber Ensemble members and students proficient in the keys of A, D and G, major/minor modes, slurred bowings. Repertoire: from Bach and Vivaldi to Bartók and Mussorgsky. This club prepares students for Thursdays' rehearsals at a slower pace; focusing on difficult passages under tempo and challenging bowings. Practice is required 4 times weekly.

Artistic expression and imaginative design are crucial skills for young students to hone in order to become creative thinkers and leaders. Watercolors will be a fun and artistic experience for children this spring. We will observe nature and different artist's approach to the world of watercolors to create our own masterpieces. Students at all levels will be able to appreciate this fun form of art, and will go home each week with their masterpiece to show off to friends and family! Come explore your creative talent in watercolors with Ms. Lynch!

## New York City Kids w/ Ms. Laurel

In the urban farming club, we will utilize the rooftop garden and learn about where food really comes from. We will grow things like lettuce, basil, tomatoes, and so much more! We will also incubate eggs in the classroom and learn how to take care of newborn baby chicks. We'll cover all the steps—planting, watering, weeding, transplanting, and harvesting, and everything in between! Students will also delve into topics of environmental education like worm composting, recycling, biodiversity, and sustainability.
