

**Larson 2019
Talent Show
Audition Packet**



Rehearsals: Being part of the Talent Show is tons of fun, but it takes a lot of time and effort. Please consider all of your spring commitments before auditioning for the talent show. **You MUST be present for all rehearsals and performances!**

Auditions: Each student wishing to have a role in the talent show must submit, electronically, an audition video. This includes performers, emcees, and backstage crew. Your performance must be under 3 minutes long in order to be considered!!! All submissions must be submitted prior to end of the school day on February 12th. **It should be known that just because a student auditions does not mean they will have a role in the talent show.** The cast list will be posted on the collaboration studio window on February 15th.

How to Audition: To audition, you must record and submit a video under 3 minutes long to the Schoology group called "2019 Larson Talent Show". To join the group, go to "groups" on Schoology. **Enter the code: G886V-FPD8C.** To be considered, you must submit a video of your full act to the Schoology discussion on this group page. You ALSO MUST fill out and submit the Audition Information Google Form located in the "resources" section of the Schoology group. See below for how to "audition" for backstage and emcee roles.



Vocalists: No suggestive or vulgar language will be allowed. Vocalists must perform with accompaniment (no "singing along" to the original recording). Therefore, you need to arrange for live accompaniment or purchase a karaoke version of the song and BURN IT TO A CD. Ipods/phones cannot be used for accompaniment. If you are unable to provide an accompaniment, you must talk to Ms. Lalla, Mrs. Rogers, or Mrs. Kirby well in advance to solve the problem.

Backstage Roles: If a student wishes to only participate in a backstage role such as lighting, sound, and props, we welcome them to the talent show. However, we ask that you explain why they would make a good addition to the backstage crew. All backstage crew members must attend ALL rehearsals. **To "audition": please submit a video under 3 minutes explaining why you would be a good choice for the role you desire. Please tell us if you have any experience in that area.** Some training will be provided.

Emcees: We will need a maximum of 6 emcees. An emcee is the master of ceremony. In other words, the announcers for the different acts with witty anecdotes. If interested, you will work with the other emcees to write the introductions for each act. You must be comfortable in front of an audience. **To "audition": please submit a video under 3 minutes explaining why you would make a great emcee!**
