

2019 Robinson Talent Show Registration, Preliminary Information & Guidelines

It's that time again...the talent show is around the corner! We are looking forward to another great show! **Please read the information below carefully.** More detailed information will be provided after registration.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

We ask that all registrations be submitted online. This will assure that we collect all required information and that submissions are legible. Please make sure to spell names correctly (the information from your registration will be used for the program). The link to the online form is:

- Please note that the registration fee is *\$10 per participant*. The sponsor parent will submit one check on behalf of all participants in their act. The registration fee will be collected at your checkpoint (see below).
- Important dates:
 - **March 11th** – registration opens
 - **March 18th** – **registration deadline**

DVD ORDERS

DVD's of the show will be available for purchase. An online order form will be distributed after registration closes. Checks for the DVD's will also be collected at the checkpoint.

CHECK POINT DATES/TIMES – Robinson cafeteria

- You will be able to select your preferred day for your check point on the registration form:
 - **Tues., April 16th starting @ 2:35**
 - **Wed., April 17th starting @ 1:25**
- Be prepared to show at least 1 minute of your act
- **Please also bring your edited music to your checkpoint** on an iPhone.
- Registration and DVD fees will be collected.

TALENT SHOW & REHEARSAL – Mira Costa HS

- **Rehearsal – Monday, May 20th**
 - o rehearsal will start at 3:30, but your call time will depend on the placement of your act in the show
 - o you will need to bring your 22” x 28” poster board announcing your act
- **Show – Wednesday, May 22nd @ 4:30 (call time for all acts is 4:00)**

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES – **please read**

- Your act/music cannot be longer than 2 minutes.
- In an effort to keep the show to a reasonable length, **solos are not allowed except for 5th graders**. We encourage students to coordinate with other students for group performances.
- **Kinder - 4th graders may only be in one act...no exceptions.**
- **5th graders** – as with previous years, 5th graders may perform in two acts (in addition to the class/finale act). One of the 2 acts must have a minimum of 4 students included.

POST-SHOW CELEBRATION

- As always, we plan to have free ice cream for participants, food trucks, and music at the conclusion of the show to celebrate the kids’ hard work! Please plan to stay for dinner and some fun!
