#### A. East Tech Celebrations

- 1. Over \$5,000,000 in scholarships for first time in East Tech history
- 2. 97% students accepted into college in Nevada and across the United States

#### B. Testing Updates

- 1. Currently in EoC (End of Course) testing
  - a) 10 left to test in science
  - b) 11 left in ELA
- 2. Math (this and next week - 9th this week and 10th next week)
  - a) Scheduled by English class - testing by English class
    - (1) 523 students will take Math II and 400 for Math I
- 3. Make Up Testing: Last week of school
- 4. EoCs are High Stakes Tests: Students must pass
  - a) This is why we are testing one a day vs multiple tests in a day
- 5. Testing based on optimum testing environment for students based on teacher schedules and available technology
- 6. Makeup Nevada Workplace Readiness and EoP (End of Program) exams happening next week also
- 7. AP Testing
  - a) 15% increase in both AP enrollment and in students taking tests

#### C. State of the School Updates

- 1. Staffing Updates
  - a) East Tech currently has opening positions:
    - (1) 1 English Opening, 2 Computer Science Openings, 1 Health Science Opening, and Kelli Harewood moving to Teacher Education, vacancy in English and 1 Custodial opening - daytime
  - b) Involuntary transfer season is upon us
  - c) East Tech has received new tables for the quad area from food services
  - d) Stay tuned for some awesome special projects in cafeteria
  - e) East Tech freshening up of the quad with the help of construction
  - f) Allotment Received : \$66,000 for Programs of Study from CTE
  - g) For Next Year: \$59,000 allotment for CTSO travel money (as opposed to the district dispersing the funds)
  - h) End of school year
