School Opening

Wednesday, September 5, 2018 will be the opening day of school in South Lane School District. With many of the schools using a staggered start, parents should refer to the information provided by their child's school. Parents of students new to the district can contact the District Office if unsure which school your child will be attending.

Kindergarten Staggered Start

Approximately 2,500 students are expected to be attending South Lane schools this year.

Food Service

South Lane School District serves nutritious meals daily that meet standards set by the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Recent changes to the meal program require all lunches to include one ½ cup serving of fruit or vegetable. The cost is:

**Breakfast price is for a complete meal. A student may decline 1 food component. (e.g. bread, meat, milk) At least ½ cup of either a fruit or vegetable must be selected.*

***Lunch price is for a complete meal. A student may decline 2 food components (e.g. bread, meat, milk, fruit, vegetable), but must select at least ½ cup of either a fruit or vegetable.*

****Milk is included in Breakfast and Lunch prices. (No free milk program is available)*

Daily payment is acceptable, but prepayment is much appreciated. Prepayment of meals allows the lines to go faster. Charges are not acceptable, and will be allowed only in an emergency. First time users will need to call 942-3381 ext. 125 to receive a pass code.

 - b) Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF); or
 - c) Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations; or

If you qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch you also qualify for Free Breakfast and Free Lunch. *The Oregon legislature recently provided funding to eliminate the reduced price payment for School Breakfast and School Lunch, breakfast and lunch will be accessible at no charge to students who qualify for reduced price meals.*

Immunizations

By law, shots are required for children in attendance at public and private schools, preschools, childcare facilities, and HeadStart programs. Oregon's Compulsory School Immunization Law (ORS.267) requires that every child in any Oregon school must be fully immunized against certain contagious diseases, or provide statements to the effect that the child is excused from immunization on religious or medical grounds. The school must be shown proof of immunizations prior to school enrollment. Transfer students will have a 30-day grace period to have their records forwarded.

Vaccines protecting against diphtheria, tetanus, polio, measles, mumps, rubella, Hepatitis B and varicella or history of chicken pox disease are required for all students. For children under 5 years of age, shots against Haemophilus influenza type b (Hib) are also required.

For additional information about immunizations and any changes in requirements contact Lane County Public Health Services at 682-4041, or the school where your child will be enrolled.

Parents should consult their health care provider for additional information.

Elementary School Registration

The registration for elementary students who are NEW to the district will begin at all elementary schools on Wednesday, August 8.

All students entering kindergarten must be five years of age on or before September 1. Certification of birth date is required at the time of registration.

The Bohemia attendance area includes the area in Cottage Grove west of the railroad tracks including Bennett Creek Drive, River Road N., River Road S., and the Silk Creek-Gowdyville areas. The southern boundary is the intersection of River Road S. and Highway 99 S. Students who live in the area north of Main Street, west of Gateway Boulevard, and south of the Cottage Grove connector will also attend Bohemia.

The school day begins at 8:20 a.m. and ends at 2:30 p.m. Beginning Wednesday, September 5, all students will be released at 1:30 p.m. on Wednesdays. Bohemia students will receive a letter explaining a staggered start which will be September 5-8.

School pictures will be taken at registration. Language Arts/Social Studies teachers will make locker assignments on the first day of classes.
