

## **SERVICE-LEARNING REFLECTION**

### **What is it?**

A service-learning reflection is a piece of writing that documents the service you provided and the lesson learned as a result. Your reflection should be a **minimum of two paragraphs**.

### **Why do I have to write a reflection?**

The CPS service-learning requirement is meant to help students “build a strong sense of agency among young people” and develop social, civic and academic skills. The written reflection is needed to demonstrate how your service experience has helped you grow and develop those skills.

### **What happens if I don't complete the reflection?**

If you do not complete the reflection, you will NOT receive service-learning credit for your work.

### **Do you need help writing your reflection?**

Refer to the prompts below if you need help getting started.

Paragraph 1 should answer the following:

1. What did service did you perform?
2. What work did you do?

Paragraph 2 should answer the following:

1. How did you feel before you completed the service?
2. How did you feel after you completed the service?
3. What did you learn from your experience?
4. How have you changed as a result of completing the service?
