Points of Interest

- **Van Driver Needed** – We are looking for someone who would be interested in driving a large van for student transportation from the Everett/Lynnwood area. - **Remind** – We use the Remind app to communicate reminders and other quick notes to parents. This is also how we let you know if school is delayed or cancelled due to weather. You can receive the messages via text or email. Attached you will find instructions on how to sign up for the Parents Remind. Athletics and the music dept. also use this app to communicate with their groups.
- **Volunteers** – If you plan to volunteer on campus, you must have a current background screening on file. Volunteer options includes but is not limited to helping in the classroom, driving on field trips, & helping with hot lunch. Screenings are good for 3 years. If you would like to become a volunteer, the instructions are attached, or if you need to check the status of your screening please contact the school office.
- **Morning Drop-off/Afternoon Pickup** – The visitor spaces along the front drive will be closed during morning drop-off to help keep kids safe when crossing the main drive.
- **Student Drivers** – All students driving need to register for parking on campus at the School Office. You must do this each year, even if you have driven and had a parking space in past years. Spaces are limited and available on a first come-first served.
- **Parking Spaces** – All numbered spaces on campus are assigned and reserved for teachers and students between 7 am and 4 pm. Please use the “Visitor” spaces by the office when you are on campus during the day. Or you can use the un-numbered spaces facing the field during drop-off and pick-up.
- **Hot Lunch Helpers** – If you are able to help with our hot lunch program this year you must have a current Food Handlers License. If you need to renew or apply for a license, please visit King County’s Health Services website to complete the online requirements.
- **Hot Lunch Account** - If you are planning to have your child eat hot lunch please remember to put money on their lunch account or send cash. All hot lunch money is payable KSDA.
