



2018-2019 Elementary Redistricting

“For Your Information”

- **Owasso Public Schools has a district boundary that forms the outline of our entire district.**
- **Within the district boundary, currently there are eight (8) elementary schools (Ator, Bailey, Barnes, Hodson, Mills, Northeast, Smith, Stone Canyon).**
- **Each elementary school has boundary lines to indicate which students attend that particular school.**
- **In August 2019, the ninth elementary school (Morrow) will be completed.**
- **Due to growth and the addition of the new elementary school, new elementary boundary lines need to be drawn for the district.**
- **A team of twenty-four (24) parents - three from each of the current elementary schools - is participating in a redistricting process to recommend new boundaries.**
- **The redistricting team will be working from November 2018 to March 2019.**
- **The goal of the redistricting team is to present a recommendation to the Board of Education on March 12, 2019.**
- **The new boundaries will take effect in August of 2019.**
- **In November, the redistricting team set the following goals for the redistricting plan:**
 - **Proximity for students to their neighborhood school with the following considerations:**
 - **Walkability to school**
 - **Commute time (car/bus)**
 - **Create the minimal changes necessary for an effective plan**
 - **Create the best long-term changes**
- **All Owasso students attend the same secondary schools:**
 - **Owasso 6th Grade Center**
 - **Owasso 7th Grade Center**
 - **Owasso 8th Grade Center**
 - **Owasso High School (9th through 12th Grades)**
