Our goals in the purchase include providing students and staff a safe learning environment for staff and students and refine our understanding of the SSIP purchasing protocols. A brief description and rationale for each item follows:

Video Surveillance/Cameras: A total of 37 camera units will be replacing the existing camera system.

Video Surveillance/Server Switch: This will replace the outdated recorder/server currently in use. Wires have been pulled and the final step is the purchase and installation of 37 cameras, the switches, and the recorder.
