I am sending this message to officially announce that Mililani High School's teachers returned to school virtually yesterday. Our teacher teams and administration have begun the work of collaborating for the start of virtual instruction through a distance learning model on Monday April 7, 2020.

In preparation for Mililani High to conduct classes virtually, we will be sending out a survey to each student to assess their readiness to access MHS on-line at home. This email went to their Mililani High School gmail account.** If we do not hear from your student, we will contact your family.

Our teachers are working hard to revise essential curriculum and to have an overview of each course for your child ready to go on April 7th. Please be patient as more communication will be emailed to students from their teachers regarding how each of their classes will be conducted.
