

Cheney Public Schools Harvest of the Month



May – Spring Greens

Lettuce is rich in Vitamin A, potassium and fiber. Salads are a great way to introduce kids to cooking. Lay out a variety of

vegetables and let them decide which favorites to include in their own salad recipe. You may want to try the ranch dressing below, too!

Homemade Ranch Dressing

Ingredients

¾ cup sour cream	½ cup whole milk
1 T lemon juice	2 T parsley, chopped
½ tsp. salt	½ tsp. onion powder
½ tsp. black pepper	¼ tsp. dried dill
¼ tsp. garlic powder	

Directions

Stir together milk and lemon juice in a small bowl. Set aside for 5-10 minutes. Combine milk mixture and sour cream in a medium sized bowl, whisking until smooth. Add dry ingredients and whisk until thoroughly combined. Transfer dressing to a jar with a tight-fitting lid and refrigerate. Shake before each use. Keeps for at least a few weeks in the refrigerator.
