Tick Information Warmer weather has arrived, and with that brings out insects. Ticks are becoming more common in our area. Ticks can be as small as a poppy seed, and can grow to a larger size. Ticks attach themselves to a body often in places that are hidden such as; arm pits, belly buttons, groin area, and behind ears. These are common places, but ticks can attach themselves anywhere. If your child has been playing outside make sure to check them for ticks after. Ticks are commonly found in wooded areas. They can also be brought into homes with your pets that pick them up outside. Prevention of tick bites is key. Make sure to use a bug spray containing DEET, pants and long sleeve shirts to try to prevent ticks if you know you will be out in the woods. Treat your pets.
