COLLEGE-PREPARATORY CURRICULUM

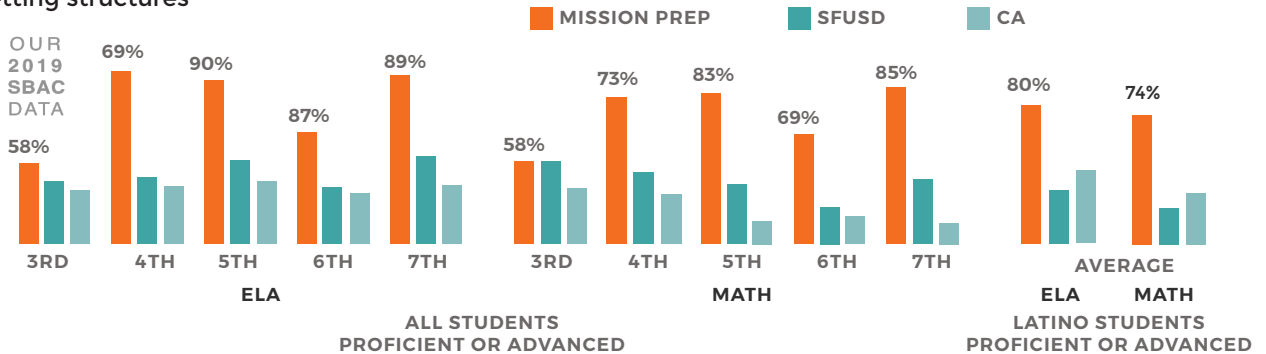
- Intensive focus on literacy (over 90 minutes a day) with differentiated instruction

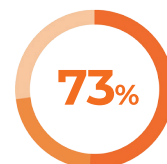
