## Students Who Forget Their Lanyards



### • Before 1<sup>st</sup> Period

- Purchase a replacement identification card and/or lanyard in the front office for \$2 each.
- Families can drop off lanyards and/or identification cards in the main office.

### • No Consequence

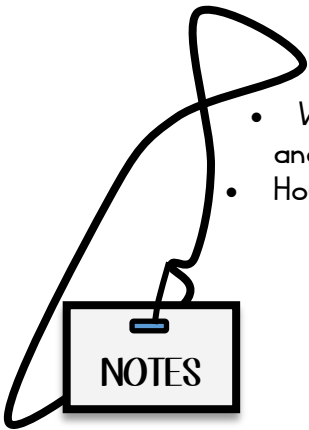


### • Once 1<sup>st</sup> Period Begins

- Student will be sent to the Deans' Office to obtain a temporary lanyard and ID.

### • Consequence

- The student will serve a lunch detention on the same day.
- During detention, students will create a plan of action to make sure they wear their lanyard and ID every day.
- **WHY?** So students are following Gibson's Dress and Appearance policy and do not miss class time in order to correct the dress code infractions.



- We appreciate families' help with bringing Lanyard and IDs to support our students and school.
- However, please note the following items:
  - If a student finds the Lanyard and ID *after* their first class begins, they will still serve their lunch detention.
  - Lanyard and IDs will not be delivered to students in class because it disrupts learning.
