The polls were opened at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 21, 2019 in the Wolcott Street School Library/Media Center for the purpose of voting on the 2019-20 School Budget, the establishment of a Capital Reserve Fund, modifications to the Transportation Policy, the 2019-20 Library Budget, Election of Three School Board Members and Election of One Woodward Memorial Library Trustee.

**PROPOSITION NO. ONE**

RESOLVED: That the Board of Education of the Le Roy Central School District in the Counties of Genesee and Livingston be authorized to expend the sum of \$25,909,998.00 for the 2019-20 school year and to accumulate no planned balance and levy the necessary tax therefor.

**PROPOSITION NO. TWO**

RESOLVED: That the Board of Education of the Le Roy Central School District in the Counties of Genesee and Livingston be authorized and directed to establish a reserve fund pursuant to Education Law Section 3651 to be known as the "General Capital Reserve Fund," for the purpose of paying, in whole or in part, the costs of additions, alterations, renovations or other improvements to District buildings and facilities, site improvements at District facilities and grounds, including athletic fields, playgrounds, recreation areas, parking areas, roadways, sidewalks and other site improvements, the acquisition of school buses and other vehicles, and the acquisition and installation of machinery, equipment, apparatus or furnishings, with the ultimate amount of such reserve fund not exceeding five million dollars (\$5,000,000) plus any accrued earnings on amounts deposited in such reserve fund, the probable existence of said reserve fund being ten (10) years, but said reserve fund continuing in existence for its stated purpose until liquidated in accordance with Education Law, and the source from which funds shall be obtained for said reserve fund being (a) current and future unappropriated fund balances from the General Fund of the School District, as directed by the Board of Education, (b) any other appropriations authorized by the voters from time to time, and (c) fund balances transferred from other reserve funds of the

School District, as may be authorized by the Board of Education or the voters from time to time.

**PROPOSITION NO. THREE**

RESOLVED, That the Board of Education of the Le Roy Central School District in the Counties of Genesee and Livingston be authorized to extend the District's current policy for transporting students in grades 1-3 from the existing distance limitation of greater than three quarters (3/4) of a mile to providing all students in grades 1-3 with transportation to and from school (no distance limitation).

**PROPOSITION NO. FOUR**

RESOLVED: That the Trustees of the Woodward Memorial Library in the Counties of Genesee and Livingston be authorized to expend the sum of \$332,000.00 to support the Woodward Memorial Library for the 2019-20 school year.

Other business before the voters was the Annual Election of candidates for three positions as members of the Board of Education.
