Establishing the Scholarship

The *Harvey Alumni Association Scholarship* was established for Harvey High graduates and is administered by the Harvey Alumni Association in conjunction with the Painesville City Local Schools administrative designee in coordination with the Harvey High School College Scholarship Counselor. This scholarship was established with funds earned by the Harvey Alumni Association in annual fund-raising efforts.

Purpose and Award Criteria

The scholarship is to provide financial support for a graduate of Harvey High School who meets the standards for admission to an accredited college, university, community college, or trade/technical school.

The graduate must demonstrate evidence of:

- 1) academic achievement (G.P.A minimum of 2.5)
- 2) involvement in school and community activities
- 3) employment/savings toward college education
- 4) writing a one page essay regarding the student's plans for a post-secondary program of studies. The essay should explain reasons for selecting the program, high school preparation for the program, work experience, reasons for selecting the school, and the student's career goals.
- 5) recommendation from a Harvey teacher/counselor/administrator and a community leader
- 6) financial need

Scholarship Details

- One or more scholarships may be given each year. The Harvey Alumni Association in conjunction with the Painesville City Local Schools administrative designee will determine the amount of the award based on the investment interest earned during the prior year.
- Completed applications should be turned in to the guidance office by April 1.

Distribution of Scholarship Funds

The scholarship will be awarded by the Alumni Association in conjunction with the Painesville City Local School administrative designee prior to the beginning of the fall semester of the student's freshman year after a copy of the student's acceptance letter to the college/university and a copy of the student's fall schedule of classes have been provided to the Harvey Alumni Association/ in conjunction with the Painesville City Local Schools administrative designee. Both should be mailed to the Harvey Alumni Association, 200 West Walnut Avenue, Painesville, Ohio 44077. The scholarship check will be sent to the student.

The Harvey Alumni Association and Harvey Alumni Endowment Fund:

- have presented, since 1991, thousands of dollars in scholarships to Harvey seniors going on to higher education. These named scholarships have included Harvey Alumni Association Scholarships, Duane Perkins, '68 Memorial Scholarships, and John J. Murphy, '60 Memorial Scholarships.
- have established with the Harvey Alumni Endowment Fund 1) *the Theodore A. & Barbara H. Beckwith Memorial Scholarship*, 2) *the Colonel Arville L. Hickerson Scholarship*, and 3) *the Dr. William H. & Hazel B. Hickerson Lake Erie College Scholarship*. Fund with gifts of \$170,000.00 from Colonel Arville L Hickerson, who grew up in Painesville and graduated from Harvey High School in 1952. The scholarship funds are invested with the Cleveland Foundation in order that the scholarships will be given in perpetuity.
- have donated \$7,000.00 to the elementary instrumental music program to help purchase “loaner” instruments for students who cannot afford to purchase or rent their own instruments
- have joined forces with the Riverside Alumni Association in sponsoring yearly the annual Riv-Har Duck Race to raise funds for scholarships and alumni activities at each school.
- have inducted more than many alumni into the “Hall of Fame of Distinguished Graduates” which annually honors Harvey Alumni who have made special contributions through their accomplishments that reflect well on Harvey High School and our community.
- have donated funds to Thomas Harvey High School to sponsor the Red Raider Pride Program. The Positive Support Behavior System at Harvey is based on the use of reinforcing school pride, positive behaviors, effort, respect, character, etc.
- have installed the Ronald C. Balogh Brick Walkway in front of the original Thomas W. Harvey High School which was then moved to the new Harvey High School
- sponsored “Last Dance” at Harvey "Classic". Over 700 alumni and guests celebrated their “Last Dance” at the original Thomas W. Harvey High School on Labor Day weekend in 2009.
- sponsored “First Dance” for Alumni and friends in the new Thomas W. Harvey High School on May 28, 2011.
- organized and maintain historical documents in the Alumni Archives room at Thomas W. Harvey High School.
- have installed the stones that were above the front doors of the original Harvey and the original cornerstone into a brick wall at the front right corner of the new Thomas W. Harvey High School - “As the Opportunity, So the Responsibility”, “Education is the Safeguard of Democracy” and the 1922 cornerstone. The bronze plaques from Harvey “Classic” are on the back side of the wall.
- have a web site at www.harveyalumni.com where information is shared with Harvey Alumni.
- established the Alumni Endowment Fund for Harvey High School in 1994. The Endowment Fund now has investment accounts with the Cleveland Foundation which will assure the process of “giving back” to the Harvey community in perpetuity.
- have donated funds to the Harvey Video Program for their help in converting historic 16mm films and VHS tapes of athletic events, assemblies, proms, homecomings, and music and drama presentations into DVDs. These digital programs are available to Harvey Alumni on YouTube.
