### **PARENT PRESENTATION - "HOW PAIN WORKS"**

Many of you know Ken Tanpinco, the father of Noah (8) and Charlotte (5). Mr. Tanpinco, a therapeutic pain specialist, is completing his doctorate and is studying how education can help people, especially young students, manage pain. The goals of his study including 1) the reduction of chronic pain, 2) the

reduction in the need for opioids, thus reducing the number of people with opioid addiction, 3) improvement of students' coping strategies to manage pain, and 4) reduction in the number of school sick days (which directly correlates to missed work days later in life).

Mr. Tanpinco has offered to conduct a presentation to all our students in grades 5 - 8. He has also offered the opportunity for parents to come to hear the same presentation. This is a valuable lesson and is definitely worth an hour of your time.

Mr. Tanpinco will present "How Pain Works" to parents on Wednesday, October 17th, at 7:00pm in the Hall. Parents who attend will be granted 1.5 service hours.

Mr. Tanpinco will present "How Pain Works" to students in grades 5 - 8 on Friday, October 26th. Thank you, Mr. Tanpinco (soon to be "Dr. Tanpinco!"), for sharing your expertise with our community.
