

Registration Requirements

Complete a student application, available on our website: www.hartdistrict.org/lpost
Attend a parent-student "intake" information meeting with the principal of Learning Post.
Demonstrate a willingness and ability to complete school work independently and on time.
Provide previous test scores at an above basic level in English and Math.

Attendance Requirements

Meet with assigned teacher at a regularly scheduled appointment time.
Sign the student contract stating that all assigned course work will be completed, and that you will uphold the expectations of academic integrity.
Participate in all state mandated testing.
Complete a minimum of 25-30 hours of assigned school work independently each week.
Provide documentation to support stated course work.

Within a flexible and supportive learning environment, Learning Post High School students and staff work together towards achieving a high school diploma and developing a foundation for a successful life beyond high school.

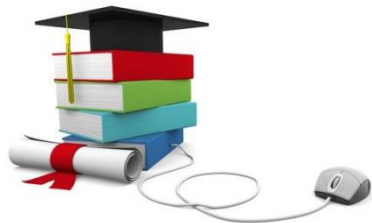
Expected Schoolwide Learning Results:
