

DISMISSAL INFORMATION

Students who are NOT attending the After-School Program will be dismissed at 2:30pm every day. If students are not picked up by 2:45pm, teachers will transition students to the After-School Program and regular rates will apply. Families will not be allowed into the school building between the hours of 2:15pm to 2:30pm. This is a very busy time and teachers are getting students lined up in the hallways for dismissal. If you have an emergency during that time frame, please contact the office prior to that time so we can help you. If you have a pre-scheduled meeting with a teacher, please let the teacher on Dismissal Duty know and they will contact the Main Office.



THE LOCATIONS WHERE STUDENTS CAN BE PICKED UP AT DISMISSAL:

GRADES 2.9, PRE-K, GRADES 2 & 3: All students in 2.9, Pre-K, grade 2 and grade 3 will dismiss from the Richmond Street side of the school which is located near the large footprint of our playground. This is on the right side of the school building if you are facing the main door from Dorchester Ave.

GRADES K1, K2 AND GRADE 1: All students in K1, K2 and grade 1 will dismiss on the Gymnasium side of the building at the FIRST DOOR closest to Dorchester Ave. This is on the left side of the school building if you are facing the main door from Dorchester Ave.

GRADES 4 THROUGH 8: All students in grades 4 through 8 will dismiss on the Gymnasium side of the building at the SECOND DOOR closest to the Gymnasium.



THERE ARE NO CARS ENTERING THE PROPERTY AT ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL. THIS IS A POLICY THAT ALL MUST FOLLOW FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR STUDENTS AND STAFF.

Please note students who are using buses will be dismissed at 2:15pm with our Bus Duty staff members. Please contact BPS transportation if you would like more information on buses and the application.
