To be considered, applicants must hold, or be eligible to hold a Wisconsin Department of Instruction Broadfield Science/Science license and be certified to teach 7th grade. Applicants must also upload a resume, three (3) letters of recommendation, a copy of their teaching certificate and a copy of their college transcript(s). In addition, applicants must include their current (or expected) salary in their application.

- Uses current technology to enhance instruction, for record-keeping and for research.
- Applies knowledge of current research and theory to instructional program.
- Evaluates students' academic and social growth and provides continuous feedback and progress reports.
- Creates an environment that is safe and conducive to learning by providing supervision, building positive relationships and by encouraging social interaction, active engagement and self-reflection.
- Communicates with students and parents on a regular basis through phone calls, emails and in-person meetings.
- Participates collegially in professional meetings (in-service, faculty, department, grade level and evaluation), professional development, continuing education and professional organizations.
- All other duties that may be assigned, in a manner that will meet the standards established by the Superintendent and/or the Board of Education.
