-Student Scholarships.org. Various scholarships. Open to all with deadlines from January 24 – March 31, 2019.

-Red Pine Scholarship. Available to low to middle income families, strong academic record or have shown significant improvement over time and planning to enroll as a freshman at a competitive 4 year college. Deadline Feb 15, 2019.

-Yawkey Scholars Program. Available to students with a strong academic record or have demonstrated a significant improvement over time, planning on attending a competitive private college in Massachusetts, engaged in a significant mentoring or leadership role and have unmet financial need and would benefit from the scholarship. Deadline is Feb 14, 2019.

-2019 National Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association Scholar/Essay Scholarship: Open to seniors who have a B+ average, ranked in the top 25% of their class, have an ACT score of 24 or higher or a SAT score of 1100, must have participated in two sports, must have one varsity letter. Deadline Feb 28, 2019.

-Westport Town Scholarship-Open to all Seniors (17 different town scholarships are available). Deadline April 5, 2019. Applications are turned into Mrs. Ruel.

-Massachusetts Shellfish Offices Association. Must be majoring in Biology. Deadline April 5, 2019.

-Cohen and Jaffe, LLP College Scholarship. Open to all. Deadline is April 5, 2019

-Massachusetts Broadcasters Association Scholarship. Must be enrolling in a broadcast-related field. Deadline is April 12, 2019.

Students who have demonstrated community service and have established academic merit. Deadline April 15, 2019.

-Greater Southeastern Massachusetts Labor Council. Open to students whose parents, legal guardians, aunts, uncles, or grandparents are members of a labor union affiliated with the Greater Southeastern Massachusetts Labor Council. Deadline is April 19, 2019.

-The Little Theatre of Fall River-The Little Theatre of Scholarship. Open to All. Deadline May 1, 2019.

-The Little Theatre of Fall River Performing Arts. Three separate scholarships. Students must be majoring in Music, Dance or the Arts. Deadline May 1, 2019.

-Domingos T. Silva Family Scholarship Fund. Open to All. Deadline May 1, 2019. Must return application to Mrs. Ruel by April 22, 2019.
