Teacher/Staff Agreement

- Provide equal access to core curriculum (CCSS) through high-quality instruction utilizing research-based strategies
- Maintain a classroom with clear academic and behavioral standards, goals, and expectations (PBIS)
- Listen to and respond appropriately to student problems or concerns in academic, behavioral, and/or social/emotional areas
- Hold parent/teacher conferences bi-annually during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to their individual child's needs
- Provide ongoing communication with parents regarding student progress and support strategies including parent conferences, newsletters, emails, phone calls, text messages
- Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's classroom, observe classroom activities, and be involved in school based and MSPTO activities throughout the year
