Registration Fee: \$500 for returning families

Registration Fee: \$1000 for new TK and K families - \$500 to be applied towards first month's tuition.

In-Parish Tuition Rates:

In-parish tuition rates apply **only to Catholic families, who are registered members of the Church of Saint Mark for at least six calendar months prior to June 2018, and who attend Mass and support Saint Mark parish by using the Sunday envelope on a weekly basis with a minimum contribution of \$20 (online giving included).** The commitment to support and attend the Church of Saint Mark applies during the full period of enrollment at Saint Mark Elementary School. Father Paul Spellman will confirm the in-parish status of school families who designate that this is their current status on the re-enrollment contract for the 2018-2019 school year.

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Tuition Payment Schedule:

Tuition, supplies, camp and technology fees will be automatically debited from your designated account by **FACTS**, our tuition management service, over an 11-month payment cycle from **July 1, 2018 through May 20, 2019**. If registration takes place after July 1, 2018, tuition will be pro-rated over the remaining months of the payment cycle. The charge for each month (or part thereof attended) of the 10-month school year (September through June) comprises 10% (1/10) of the total tuition. No tuition refunds will be given to students who withdraw.

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING IN-PARISH STATUS VS. OUT-OF-PARISH STATUS:

If it is determined that the obligations of families who have registered as “in-parish” are not being met those accounts will be modified to be in line with out-of-parish rates. The pastor and principal will work together to make this determination. Thirty days notice will be given to these families prior to the modification applied to FACTS and it will include funds owed at the out-of-parish rate for the entire school year.

Reasons for Supplies Fee:

In order to build in a more cost effective and efficient system of providing what students need in the way of classroom supplies, we are continuing to order most items in bulk again this year. Supplies will be used communally, which provides a very efficient way of managing their use during the course of instructional time. Less time spent looking for supplies and more time on academic learning is the goal!
