

## **Jasper County School District Hybrid Model (In-Person and Virtual Blend) (Phase In)**

### **Hybrid Model Explanation**

Jasper County School District will implement its Hybrid Model using a Phase-In Approach as noted below. This model is an option for parents who selected the Hybrid Model during the registration process. The Hybrid Model will include in-person instruction as well as virtual instruction.

### **What Students Will Need for Hybrid In-Person Learning**

Students participating in the Hybrid Model are expected to bring their electronic device with them for in-person learning as well as their own earbuds. In addition, students are expected to wear a mask and bring their own school supplies. Students will not be permitted to share an electronic device, earbuds, or school supplies.

### **School Uniforms**

Students will be required to wear school uniforms to school for the Hybrid In-Person Learning Model.

### **Bus Transportation**

Transportation will be provided to and from the student's physical address. **Routes will not be altered or approved for an alternate address in the afternoon.** *It is extremely important to note that if a student does not ride the bus to school in the morning, the student will not be permitted to ride the bus in the afternoon.* This is due to the capacity restrictions on the bus and ensuring that safety is practiced. Students riding the bus are required to wear a mask.

### **Car Riders**

All students must be supervised at all times. Therefore, students who are car riders may NOT be dropped off to school early. Security will be onsite to enforce arrival and safety expectations. Car riders are to adhere to the following drop-off and pick-up times:

Elementary Car Riders: AM Drop Off: 7:00 a.m. – 7:25 a.m. (Ridgeland Elementary)

7:05 a.m. – 7:25 a.m. (Hardeeville Elementary)

PM Pick-up: 2:30 p.m. (All Car riders MUST be picked up by 3:00 p.m.)

Middle/High School Car Riders: AM Drop Off: 8:00 a.m. – 8:45 a.m.

PM Pick-up: 3:45 p.m. (All Car riders MUST be picked up by 4:15 p.m.)

### **Expectations of Students Opting for the Hybrid Model**

Students who begin the Hybrid Model will be expected to continue the Hybrid Model for the duration of the year. This ensures safety for all staff and students and maintains a consistent schedule for completion of course requirements.

**NOTE:** The above schedules are subject to change based on data released in regards to COVID-19. In addition, if the participation is minimal for those selecting the Hybrid (In-Person) Model, consideration will be given to affording students the option to attend 4 days in-person or 5 days in-person. Any changes or adjustments to the schedule will be announced by the district.

**What if My Child is a 100% Virtual Student?**

- If your child is a virtual student, your child will be expected to remain virtual for the remainder of the school term, unless otherwise changed by the district.
- All virtual students are required to log-in daily and at the appropriate class time, per their schedule.
- Any virtual student who does not log-in daily and at the appropriate class time, per their schedule, will be considered absent and reported to our Attendance Truancy Officer.
- **Virtual School Expectations will be enforced for all Virtual Students who select to Remain 100% Virtual.**
