

GREENE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

Minutes

May 14, 2015

The Greene County Board of Education met to vote on the new Director of Schools on Thursday, May 14, 2015, after the scheduled interviews, at the James W. Parham Central Office.

Chairman Rick Tipton gave instructions to the Board for the voting process. He noted that they each have a Ballot in front of them with the names of the four candidates: Mr. George Frye, Mr. David McLain, Dr. Gerald Miller, and Dr. Melinda Pruitt. He advised that one candidate must have five votes before they can be considered for appointment. He said if the first ballot has two at the top then the bottom two would be eliminated and the Board would vote again but if someone were to get five votes on the first pass then that would be the candidate that would be offered a contract.

Mr. Tipton instructed all Board members to cast their votes and to be sure to sign their names at the bottom of the ballot. Board Secretary, Trenda Berney collected the ballots and then she and Materials Clerk, Ellen Myers took the ballots to an adjoining office to tally the votes. Mrs. Berney returned with the ballots and read them aloud as follows:
