



## Oratory Prep Dress Code Guide

Oratory Prep requires a dress code for its students, but it does not require a specific school or gym uniform. The information below is a guide to your shopping experience as it relates to the OP dress code.

- **Polo Shirts:** Students are permitted to wear any polo shirts *with the Oratory Prep logo*. Polo shirts with an OP logo can be purchased at the Spirit Shoppe in DeGaeta Hall.
- **Button Down Shirts:** Students are permitted to wear any button down shirts with standard collars and without excessive logos. The OP logo is not required on the button down shirts.
- **Sweaters and ¼ Zips:** Students are permitted to wear any sweaters or ¼ zips over their button down shirts or polos, *with or without the OP logo*. Items with the OP logo can be purchased at the Spirit Shoppe.
- **Tee Shirts and Shorts:** Students are permitted to wear any tee shirts or shorts to gym. Items with the OP logo can be purchased at the Spirit Shoppe.
- **Sweatshirts:** While hooded sweatshirts are prohibited during the school day, many different styles of sweatshirts are available at the Spirit Shoppe. This allows the students to add some fun OP items to their Tag Day and non-school day wardrobe.
- **Belts:** Students are required to wear belts at all times, but there is not a uniform specific belt. Belts are available for purchase at the Spirit Shoppe.
- **Ties:** Students are only required to wear ties on certain occasions as identified by the Head of School (such as school Mass days). There is not a uniform specific tie, but ties with the OP logo can be purchased at the Spirit Shoppe.

The Spirit Shoppe is open on Wednesday afternoons from 2:30-4:00 PM, during designated hours during the summer months, and at most OP special events.
