- 5.1 Hearing: Regarding Sufficiency or Insufficiency of Instructional Materials (Ed. Code 60119).
- Dr. Torres, Assistant Superintendent updated the board on our modernization budget and the challenges of the current bidding environment. Low bid responses have been in some cases, significantly over budget, and the District has had to reevaluate some projects in order to stay within budget. Dr. Torres introduced Louis Varga of Colombo Construction, who provided some options to the board for consideration, including terminating the current contract for the concrete work at Discovery Elementary. Colombo Construction is working with the concrete contractor to determine the cost to buyout the contract to identify true savings, and recommendations will be made to the Board at a subsequent meeting.

Annual certification, after public hearing, that every student is provided with accessibility to state adopted textbooks and instructional materials in mathematics, science, history, language arts, including English Language Development (ELD), and those enrolled in foreign language class (grades 7-8).

Annual certification that the District has not exceeded its legally established appropriations limit for tax proceeds received. Proposition 4, enacted in 1979, established constitutional limits on the allowable growth in state and local government spending, including school districts. These appropriations limits, commonly called GANN limits, allow government spending to grow at a rate not faster than inflation and the change in population.
