Rio Hondo College will launch a significant expansion of its Rio Promise program, offering free tuition for **TWO** years.

Rio Hondo College is the first college in Los Angeles County to implement a second year of free tuition for students.

The program expansion will be going into effect, September 25, 2018.

Did you know you can earn college credits through some of our ROP classes?

Articulated Credit is a way to start a **college** technical major in high school.

In an **Articulated Credit** program, you begin your course of study in high school and continue in a community or technical college. Articulated classes are a good way to get ahead and earn college credits at the same time as earning your A-G credits for graduation.

Process of Articulation with Rio Hondo College:

1. Schools organize agreement between High School and College classes.
2. Students take the articulated course of choice
3. Students register for the College, and apply for correct term.
4. Students register on CATEMA
5. Students pass class with a minimum of a B grade and pass course exam, portfolio requirement, or teacher recommendation.
6. Students earn college credits!
