

Superintendent's Message Regarding Coronavirus

FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT:

Dear Luling ISD Families and Staff,

As we prepare to return after Spring Break, I want to assure you that Luling ISD is continuing to stay on top of developments related to the coronavirus in our area. The district is monitoring guidance closely from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), local health officials, Texas Education Agency, and Education Service Centers 13 and 20.

Based on guidance from the agencies listed above, the district is NOT extending Spring Break at this time. Additionally, all activities (UIL Academics, Athletics, One-Act Play, etc.) have not been cancelled and will continue as planned. Please continue to check the district website for updated information. We will also post on Facebook.

As of 1 PM today, we have learned of zero reported cases in Caldwell County. The safety and security of our students and staff is our highest priority, and the district has already taken appropriate measures to increase our cleaning and sanitizing of all buildings and buses.

We ask that if your child has recently been sick, hospitalized, or traveled outside of the country that you notify the campus principal and nurse before they return to school. Employees, please notify your immediate supervisor.
