Dear Parent:

Ohio law requires that Boards of Education must provide transportation to and from school for resident pupils in grades K-8 who live more than two miles from their school of attendance (public and non-public).

If, however, after an examination of existing school bus routes, time schedules, student residence location and available school conveyances, a Board determines it is "impractical" to transport a child or children, it may pay a parent or guardian in lieu of transporting said pupil(s). The amount to be paid to a parent may not exceed the state average cost to transport all pupils in the state the preceding year.

If you have a child or children in grades K-8 attending a non-public school outside the city of Reading, you qualify for payment in lieu of transportation for the above stated reasons.

If you wish to make application for the payment in lieu of transportation, please complete and return the Contract.

Contracts will **not** be accepted after the September 17, 2019 deadline.
