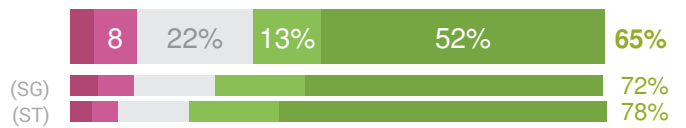
1. Some classmates tease kids who make mistakes.
