Answers to all questions should be typed in MLA format, using quotes from the novel when necessary. Assignments will be collected on the first day of classes.

**<u>Pre-reading questions:</u>** Complete the following questions prior to reading the novel.

- 1. What are some ways that decisions are reached by a group of citizens?
- 2. Why are there rules and Laws for a society to follow?
- 3. Why do some societies fall to Totalitarian rule?
- 4. What causes persons to follow the actions of others without question?
- 5. Explain why most dictatorships eventually fail.

**Read the novel in its entirety.** While reading, take notice of the characters and their interaction with each other. Annotate while reading, noting aspects of society and technology expressed by the author.

<u>Post reading questions:</u> Complete the following questions upon the completion of novel. Be sure to include quotes and examples from the story to explain your responses.

- 1. What is the setting of the novel? What is the county and city?
- 2. Describe the main character. Include his living conditions and his employment.
- 3. Explain the importance of "Big Brother" Describe his image as portrayed in the novel.
- 4. What is "Newspeak" and how does it work?
- 5. What is a "facecrime"? Give an example from the novel.
- 6. What is the aim of the Party?
- 7. What role does technology take in the party's control over the characters?
- 8. How does Winston evolve during story and how is his fate determined?
- 9. Explain the importance of Room 101.
- 10. What warning do you believe the author is sending to readers about society and government trends?
