Appropriate Clothing

It is important that clothing worn to school is appropriate for the classroom. Shorts should be of appropriate size and length. Any student wearing clothing deemed inappropriate will be asked to change clothing. **We have clothes available for students to change into so parents do not need to bring in other items unless they choose to.** There are rules in the **code of conduct** regarding bare midriffs, t-tops, beachwear, wording on T-shirts, etc. (All tank tops must have a strap at least 2 inches wide and be form fitting around the arm.) We would also like to remind parents that sagging pants and exposed undergarments are not in compliance with the MMS dress code. Parents, please help your child make wise choices **and take time to notice what your child is wearing to school. Some clothing that may be purchased at local stores may not be appropriate for school. We ask your cooperation in this area.**
