



Anna Chadwick was chosen as a semifinalist in the 2019 National Merit Scholarship Program which is the highest academic honor attainable by high school students of the United States.

Approximately 16,000 semifinalists in total were chosen in the 64th annual National Merit Scholarship Program based on their scores in last year's Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test, taken by 1.6 million high school juniors. The semifinalists get the chance to compete for 7,500 National Merit Scholarships worth more than \$31 million to be offered next spring.

To become finalists, the semifinalists must submit a scholarship application that includes a strong academic record and an account of their participation in school and community activities, leadership abilities, employment, and any honors or awards.

Over 90 percent of the semifinalists are expected to attain finalist standing and about half of the finalists will win a National Merit Scholarship, earning the Merit Scholar title.

Anna is the daughter of David and Jami Chadwick, and she holds a weighted GPA of 4.36.
