#### SFA Tardy Policy

Objective of Tardy Policy: To increase the uninterrupted instructional minutes in each learning environment for each student in our building. Arriving to class on time is crucial for teachers to be able to engage students swiftly and implement consistent classroom practices that maximize teachable moments.

1. Tardy sweeps will be conducted at the end of each passing period. Students who are tardy will report to a tardy sweeper (teacher at a designated station) to obtain a pass to class so they may enter their class.
2. **EACH** tardy throughout each day will earn a student a 30 minute after school detention, to be served in the school's cafeteria (4 tardies = 2 hours).
3. Students will have one week to serve their tardy detentions, Mondays through Thursdays only.
4. If a student serves their detentions, great! Consequence served and done.
5. If a student does not serve their detentions by the end of that week, a two hour detention will be required to be served.
6. If a student fails to serve the two hour detention, they will be assigned to a four hour community service Saturday (to be arranged by the student's grade level AP).
7. If a student fails to serve that community service, a day of ISS will be assigned **AND** the student will still be scheduled to serve the next available Saturday community service.

On most days, a phone message will go home to inform the parent that their student received a tardy that day.
