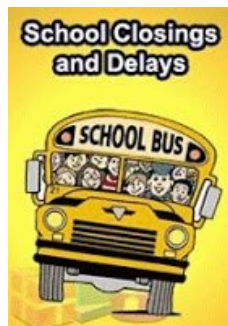


### Weather & Bus Pickups
