Description: The Student Transitional Education Program (STEP) provides a learning and independent living environment where students can develop to their fullest potential. A Youth Service Worker Supervisor 2 (Residential Supervisor) is responsible for programming, facility, equipment/supplies, and staff & students assigned to two residential cottages designated for the STEP program.

This position is a full-time 12 month position. May be required to work weekends and holidays during school year.

- High School diploma or GED equivalent
- Associates Degree preferred
- Valid Tennessee Driver's License
- Experience equivalent to two years of full-time youth service work in a residential setting preferred
- Previous management and supervision experience is also preferred

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Report directly to Assistant Principal of STEP
- Provide positive leadership of staff and students
- Provide on-the-job training for Youth Service Worker I
- Prepare reports and keep records`
- Evaluate staff performance, placement and schedules
- Inspect STEP cottages
- Conduct meetings and interface with parents
- May be required to transport student to and from work
- Help students plan and arrange for off-campus activities
- Supervise students
- Perform other duties as assigned
- May be required to work weekends
