All participants should arrive at Belleville High School for a prompt 9:00 am start, with a brown bag lunch and water bottle; please write your name on both. Dismissal will be at 3:30 pm. There will be no supervision available after 3:30 pm, so please make the proper arrangements.

Class size is limited to 60 applicants; applications will be received on a first-come/first-served basis.
