Dear Rock Island-Milan Parents and Guardians,

On Friday, March 20, Illinois Governor Pritzker announced that there is a “Stay-at-Home” order for the entire state, effective on March 21 at 5:00 p.m. through Tuesday, April 7. RIMSD #41 will continue to do whatever is necessary to take precautions to slow the spread of COVID 19, which means that all school buildings are closed and all events and activities are suspended until further notice.

The district will still provide meals to families and will have two meal kit distributions next week on Monday, March 23 and Thursday, March 26. You will receive a robo-call reminder on Sunday. We will make plans to do more meal distributions the following week through the Stay-At-Home order.
