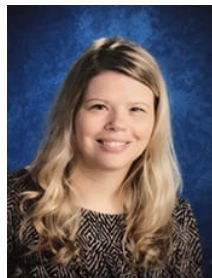

CAR RIDER INSTRUCTIONS AND DRIVING ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

Car Rider Instructions for Morning Drop Off:

There are two places that students can be dropped off in the mornings.

1. The preferred drop off in the morning is at the rear of the school at the cafeteria walkway. Use the access road on the east side of the school to drive around to the cafeteria.
2. Students can be dropped off at the front gate of the school in the mornings via the road coming into the front of the school (the bus loop). If using the front bus loop the following rules apply:
 - The bus loop is one way only; the entrance is the side closest to U.S. 301 (1st St).
 - Do not park anywhere in the bus loop, it is for drop off only.
 - **Do not pass any bus that is dropping off students in the bus loop, this is illegal and very dangerous. Wait behind the bus and only move up once the bus has driven off and all students are inside the gate.**
 - Do not drive through the parking lot in front of the school.
 - Do not drop off students in the parking lot. The parking lot is only to be used if a parent is parking and coming into the school office.

Car Rider Instruction for Afternoon Pick Up:

There is only one place that students can be picked up for afternoon dismissal.

1. All student pick up dismissal will be in the rear of the school at the cafeteria. Use the access road on the east side of the school to drive around to the cafeteria.
2. Do not use the road coming into the front of the school (the bus loop) for student pick up at dismissal. This road is for buses only at dismissal.
3. Do not park or wait in the front parking lot for students to be dismissed. No student being picked up at dismissal will be permitted to exit through the front gate. The parking lot is to be used only if a parent is parking and coming into the school office.

Attendance

Every minute in school counts! Please make sure your child is in school every day and on time. We want to give our students a greater edge in their learning experience. It is important for your child's education; we do not want them to fall behind in their work. If you have doctor appointments, please schedule them so that your child does not miss the entire school day.

Medication

Before any prescription medication can be administered in school, written authorization from the child's physician and parent must be obtained and be on file in the school office. Forms for prescription and non-prescription medication are available in the main office. All medication should be brought to school by the child's parent/guardian. **Students cannot carry any medication with them during school.**

Curriculum

This school year will be a busy one! Subjects your child will be learning are: Reading, Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, Math, and Writing. Students will have PE every day. Your child will be participating in a rigorous curriculum with high expectations. There are lots of new changes this year, so please be encouraging at home. If you have any questions, comments, or concerns, please contact your child's teacher or the office.

Reading at Home

The greatest growth we expect to see in our students is in vocabulary and fluency. To ensure your child's success, please encourage them to read fiction and non-fiction books at home for their pleasure.



Dress Code

It's in our name- we dress for success! Students must wear a clean Team Success shirt every day.

Students cannot wear:

- ❖ Leggings/ Jeggings

Your child will be sent to the office and you will be called to bring school appropriate clothing if they violate the dress code.
